This month I would like to talk about the responsibilities of the AIS Chairperson. (This position is not available for dual members).

- The Chair conducts all AIS meetings, and sets the agenda for the meeting.
- Coordinates with the Vice-Chairperson and AIS Officers to call special meetings when necessary.
- Is the Alternate Intergroup Representative.
- Coordinates the Service Workshop with the Vice Chairperson and Activities Committee.
- Attends AWSC meetings or finds a substitute.
- Reviews the By-Laws, recommends updates, and provides posting for them on the website.

At our last AIS meeting we asked members present why they said yes to service and here are some of their responses:

- "Someone expressed confidence in me that I could meet the challenge offered. That meant a lot to me."

- "By default, there were not a lot of members at my home group and I was interested in learning "behind the scenes" of how the program works."
- "I loved our literature and being involved with the book depot deepened my knowledge of CAL."

Outreach at Norris Clinic
