Service Positions Available in Districts 14, 19, 20 and 25 (Greater Rochester area)

District Representative (DR):

- Establishes and chairs regular District meetings with Group Representatives (GRs) and other members within a District
- Keeps in contact with Group Representatives and groups to answer questions and offer support
- Attends NY North Area World Service Committee (AWSC) meetings to discuss and vote on topics on behalf of Groups in their District (4 per year)
- Attends NY North Area Assemblies in support of GRs (2 per year)

A DR is a **current or past GR** who attends AI-Anon meetings regularly and practices the Twelve Steps and Traditions. Also, it is helpful if a DR has a basic knowledge of basic computer tools or is willing to learn them as part of this position.

Alternate District Representative:

- Is eligible to serve as a DR
- Steps in for the DR or completes their term if the DR is unable to serve
- often attends monthly AI-Anon Information Service (AIS) meetings
- often assists the DR in one or more capacities

- Increase Self-Esteem and Experience a Sense of Purpose

Friday - 11AM - 1PM

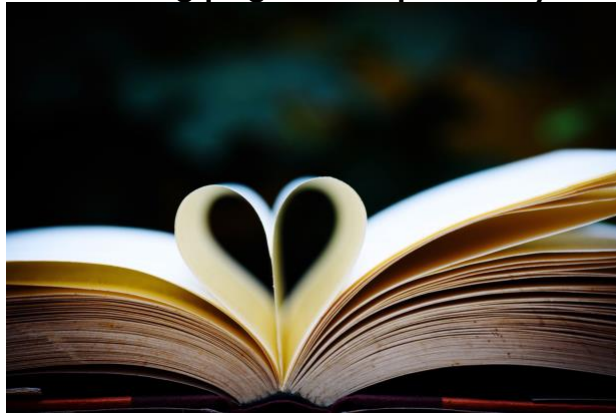
NEW! - Saturday 11AM - 2PM
