Fall Assembly Notes from September, 2025- Your Intergroup rep – Loron O.

- 50 in attendance-some met in groups in to allow fellowship/discussion and voting.
- **NY North 2026 assembly** will be in Binghamton-, agreed this would be a great experiment and allow the enthusiastic volunteers to work close

to home. Historically this assembly has been in Syracuse.

- **GR/DR monthly meetups**- finding best times to meet and asking others to chair these sessions-see schedule on NY north and AIS website.
- Thought force to discuss development of MLPP for NY North. (meeting list publishing policy) This would be a guideline if a group was to be de-listed from WSO listing.
- Book sales less than expected at WSO. Consider increased group donations.
- **Group names** in response to the 2024 guideline. This was to delete identifiers like, men, women, adult child and lgbtq from group names to be most inclusive. After the guideline published, WSO received many letters expressing opinions counter to this. ACTION-discuss with your group and bring to the area and the world conference in 2026.
- WSO is short 5 members of the **Board of Trustees**. We discussed proposals to streamline process in hopes of having more qualified candidates. See the Delegate link for more information on all WSO topics.
