OLD Business from last meeting:

Are groups allowed to earmark funds to Alateen directly?
After a conversation with WSO, and review if the Service Manual the following is suggested:

1. The AIS Rochester has a line item in the 2026 budget for Alateen of \$200
2. The goal is for Alateen to become self-supporting in accordance with the seventh tradition
3. There is no mechanism in place right now to allow earmarked funds for Alateen from a group, and it would be difficult to track these donations.
4. Pages 97 and 103 of the Service Manual provide further details.

The final decision was made by a motion to accept the earmarked Alateen monies as a donation to AIS Rochester. The motion carried.




